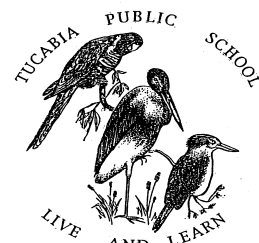

Family Mental Health Support Services (FMHSS)

OTCP now delivers this program which is early intervention support for vulnerable families with children and young people who are showing early signs of, or are at risk of developing a mental illness. It provides a range of flexible, responsive, non-clinical mental health support service to meet the needs of children and young people affected by, or at risk of mental illness, and their families and carers.

Service Delivery principles are:

- Early intervention
- Child and young person-centred
- Family focused
- Flexible
- Accessible and responsive

We are unable to work with a child or young person without the involvement of their families or carers.

Referrals can be accepted by any means as long as there is consent and does not overlap with other funded services eg in the care of DOCS.
