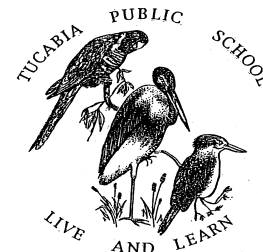

National Simultaneous Storytime

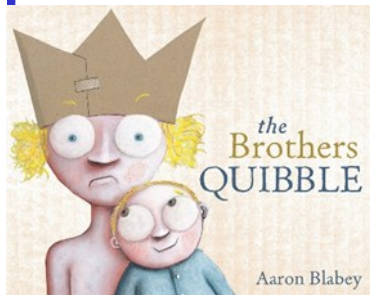
Years 3-6 were enthused by this year's featured author/illustrator Aaron Blabey when they watched a YouTube video interview about what, when, how and why he is inspired to write.

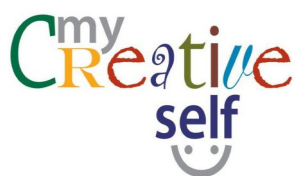
Community News

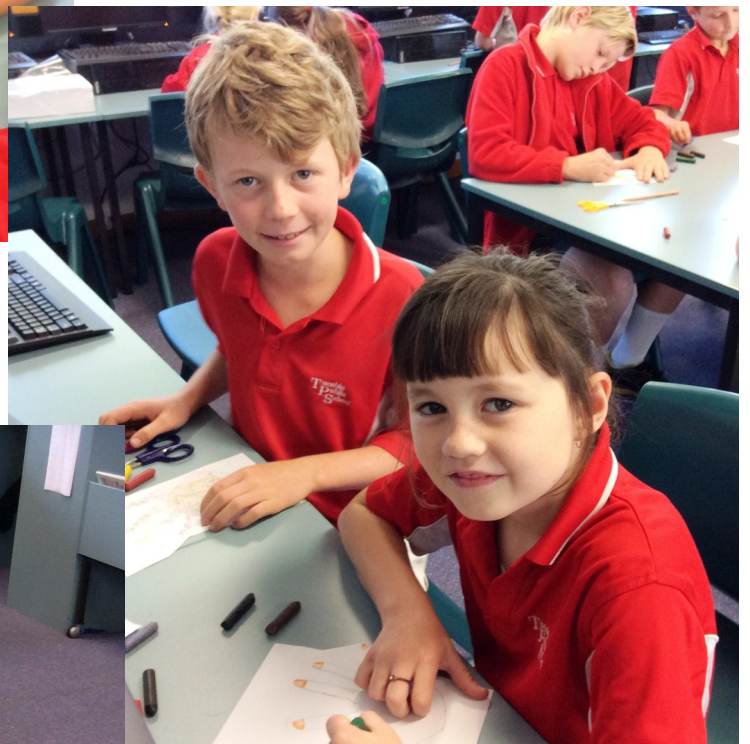
