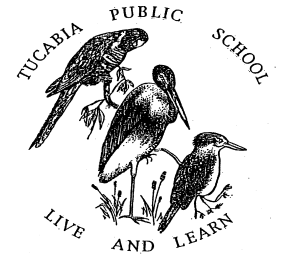

Cost: \$5.00 bus fare.

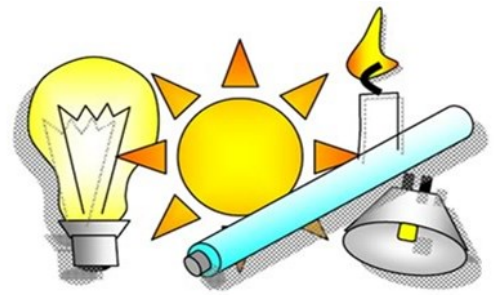
CONGRATULATIONS P&C COMMITTEE
