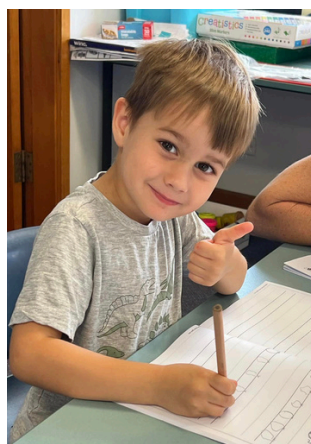
My Future Program
