A special congratulations to Mercy and Ty for reaching the impressive milestone of 100 nights of home reading, earning a \$15 Book Warehouse gift card!

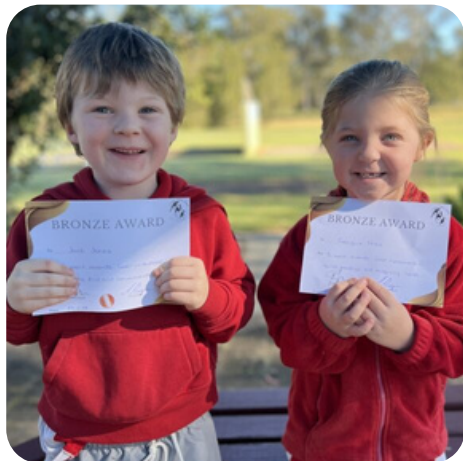
We also want to celebrate all the merit award winners for their outstanding academic achievements. Your hard work and commitment to excellence are truly commendable.
